## Resolution No. 2016-3

WHEREAS, The Kiowa County Board of Commissioners wish to provide one free load of gravel annually, as a service and a convenience, to the residents of Kiowa County since there is limited opportunity to purchase this type of product within the borders of Kiowa County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (BOCC) OF KIOWA COUNTY THAT:

- Kiowa County will provide up to one 25 yard load of gravel to each Kiowa County household annually.
- The material will be delivered to the household at no cost to them however the owner of the pit will receive normal compensation.
- The resident may request less than a full load but any portion of a load will constitute the annual entitlement. Only one delivery per household per year.
- Gravel must be requested through the Road & Bridge Foreman of the District in which the resident lives.
- Gravel will only be delivered to private property the household owns or leases.
- Gravel will be delivered at the convenience of the Road & Bridge crew.
- Delivery site will be a reasonable location considering time and equipment and will be at the discretion of the road foreman.
- The exact type of material can also be at the discretion of the road foreman, such as mostly sand, road base, or something with more rock.
- Loads may not be accrued and may not be designated to another resident.
- Should this system become the subject of abuse, manipulation or misrepresentation it may be discontinued at any time and service may be discontinued to anyone abusing the policy.
