CNG does not profit on the cost of natural gas and it is a pass-through expense. The State of Colorado and the surrounding area experienced an extreme weather event on February 13-17, 2021. As a result of the extreme weather, CNG incurred extraordinary consumption of natural gas by its retail customers necessitating that the Company purchase an unprecedented amount of

gas to meet demand during this brief period in the month of February. No customers lost service during the Extreme Weather Event, and through the efforts of dedicated Company personnel, the system was maintained, and service provided to

customers without interruption. The cost of acquiring the supplemental natural gas to meet customers' needs during this event would normally be recovered through the Company's Gas Cost Adjustment clause ("GCA").
